Cutter Boat delivered successfully by New Hellenic Shipyards



New Hellenic Shipyards acting as a member of a consortium finalized the project of building a boat for Bulgarian Port Infrastructure. The vessel is intended for monitoring and establishment of an information system of Danube riverbed.

The dimensions of the boat are L=13m, B=4.3m and T=1.15m, it has two main engines, one generator, A/C & ventilation system, accommodation area for six persons and it is fully equipped with communication and navigation electronics. It was designed by our technical department in accordance with Inland Waterways Rules and it's construction and sea trials were monitored by a Classification Society.

The building of the vessel commenced on July 2014 and the sea trials were finalized successfully on December 2014.

New Hellenic Shipyards completed the project in time and budget, keeping at the same time high quality standards and full conformance with corresponding rules and regulations.
